

# Sedalia Parks & Recreation Women's Volleyball Dusk Til Dawn Tournament



**Location:** Convention Hall Gym in Liberty Park (2 courts),

The tournament will be filled on a first come-first filled basis. Entry fee and  
registration form must be received by Friday, Jan 18.

1. Teams will compete in pool play, after pool play all teams will be placed in the single elimination tournament bracket.
2. Pool Play will consist of 2 games to 21 points. Rally score and must win by 2 points or a cap of 25 points whichever comes first.
3. Tournament standings will be based on win-loss record and then total points scored. If there is a tie between two teams then seeding will be based on points allowed.
4. Tournament play will be best 2 of 3 games rally score to 25 points, no cap and no time limit.

## Rules

1. Teams may play with a minimum of 4 players for it to be an official game.
2. If a team plays with 4 players, the server must be the one back row player that may not hit in front of the 10 foot line.
3. The serve may hit the net and go over to be good. The serve cannot be blocked, spiked or attacked at the net. You do NOT need to bump the serve.
4. Players will be given 1 warning for inappropriate language or behavior by the referee. If it occurs again, they will be asked to leave the gym.
5. Flagrant throws and catches will be called as violations.
6. Substitutions may be made by rotation in at the serve or through regular substitution rules whichever method you start the game with, is how you must continue the game.
7. Coin toss will determine side and serve.
8. No toughing the net during play.
9. You may not play off the curtain or walls. You may play off the ceiling if the ball returns to your side of the net and is not the forth hit.
10. Foot faults will be called. The entire foot must be over the centerline.
11. Appeal of a call is made through the manager of the team to the referee after the ball is dead. A manager has the right to ask for an explanation of a call, and an explanation should be given. Only the manager may ask for an explanation from the official, other players may not.
12. There will be two 30 second time-outs per game. There will be a maximum of two minutes between games.
13. If one of your team members arrives late and you are not playing with six, she may rotate in when the open spot returns to the serving position.
