2. Your four legged furry friends may call this place fun. A place to mingle with other mutts and run around freely!
3. Home to a 12 acre lake – you'll find tons of fun out at this park! From Frisbee golf to access to the Katy Trail to soccer fields to archery, this is one place you won't want to miss!
4. Grind, kickflip, and 360 spin around this location. You may also find ballfields here.
5. This park was the third park that was purchased in 1942. Here you can find a ballfield, shelter house, basketball court, and a brand new playground! Hint – located on Howard Street.
6. This park is 23 acres in size and is full of fun! Here you can find the City Hospital Memorial, basketball courts, a ballfield, shelter houses, and a playground. Stop here to shoot some hoops on your hunt!
7. Here you can find the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest park we have. Complete with 8 baseball fields. Batter up!
8. Ever heard of futsal? This is a form of soccer that can be played at this park on the courts! Hint – there is a walking path here too
9. Some like to relax, some like to swim, while others just like to snack on ice cream treats! Here you'll find a diving board.
