## Dog Park Rules

- 1. Daily hours of operation shall be from sunrise until sunset.
- 2. Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries caused by them. Users of this facility do so at their own risk.
- 3. Dogs must be currently licensed, vaccinated, and all tags must be displayed on their collar (you will need to provide licensing upon request by any City Official).
- 4. "Scoop the poop" Owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs.
- 5. Dogs that exhibit aggressive behavior are not allowed in the park.
- 6. Dogs using this facility must be at least five months old.
- 7. Spiked collars are not permitted in this facility.
- 8. Dogs must be leashed before entering and prior to leaving the facility. Owners must carry a leash at all times.
- 9. Owners/handlers must remain in the park and must maintain visual and voice contact with their dogs at all times.
- 10. Children ages 8-15 must be accompanied by an adult. Children under 8 are not allowed in the park.
- 11. Handlers must be a minimum of 16 years old.
- 12. Female dogs in heat and dogs with fresh wounds are not allowed in the park.
- 13. Only 3 dogs are allowed per handler.
- 14. No other animals are allowed into the park.
- 15. If your dog digs, it must be stopped and the hole filled in by its owner/handler.
- 16. Dog toys may be used in the park unless the use of such toys creates disruptive behavior among other dogs.
- 17. Professional trainers may not use the park for conduct of their business.
- 18. Do not bring dog food or human food into the park.
- 19. No glass containers.
- 20. No sick, diseased, or injured dogs are permitted.
- 21. No selling or giving away animals on this site.
- 22. No climbing on the fence by persons or dogs is permitted.
- 23. Keep gates closed at all times.
- 24. Violators of the rules will be subject to removal from the park and suspension of park privileges.
- 25. DOGS ARE ANIMALS, AND THEIR BEHAVIOR CANNOT BE PREDICTED OR CONTROLLED BY THE CITY. USE OF THE DOG PARK BY A PATRON CONSTITUTES AN ACCEPTANCE OF THIS DANGER AND AN ASSUMPTION OF ALL RISK TO PERSON AND PROPERTY ASSOCIATED WITH USING THE DOG PARK.

Small dogs – up to 40 pounds. Large dogs 40 pounds or more. If an owner brings a large and a small dog to this park, they must enter the large dog area.
