

# **Memorial Tree Application**

Can't decide what to get Mom and Dad for their upcoming anniversary? Looking for a lasting remembrance of a loved one? Want a unique way to celebrate the birth of your child? Through the Commemorative Tree and Memorial Bench Program, you can establish a living memorial and beautify your parks at the same time.

During the planting season (September-early March), Parks and Recreation staff will plant a tree from the list below. After planting, a memorial plaque will be installed on the commemorative tree. No flowers, cards, balloons, lights, etc. will be allowed on or below the tree in the park.

Types of trees available include Eastern Redbud, Kousa Dogwood, Little Leaf Linden, Sawtooth Oak, White Oak, Burr Oak, White Pine, Saucer Magnolia, and Tina Crabapple.

An application is available at the link below or at the Parks and Recreation office. Commemorative trees are \$200 per tree. Applications are accepted year long. *Trees are planted September 1 through March 31 each year*. For more information, contact the Sedalia Parks & Recreation Office (660) 826-4930.

## **Memorial Tree Descriptions**

The following information about available tree species may be helpful in considering a Memorial Tree. The sizes listed are "at maturity." The planting site will need to match the mature size of the tree.

#### Eastern Redbud Cercis canadensis

Height of 20-30 feet, width of 25-35 feet. It will have dark green heart-shaped leaves that turn yellow in the fall. Light shade to full sun.

#### Kousa Dogwood Cornus kousa

Height of 20-30 feet, width of 20-30 feet. This dogwood flowers white to red from May to June, with distinctive ribbed leaves of bright green that turns reddish in the fall. Shade to sunny conditions.

#### Sawtooth Oak Quercus acutissima

Height of 40-50 feet, width of 30-45 feet. The edges of the leaves are serrated and are bright green in the summer, and turn yellow in the fall. Full sun.

#### Swamp White Oak Quercus phellos

Height of 50-60 feet, width of 30-40 feet. The lustrous, heavy textured leaves change from a medium green in the summer to yellow and purple in the fall. The acorns mature and are shed in September or October of the same year.

#### Burr Oak Quercus macrocarpa

Height of 50-70 feet, width of 40-50 feet. It's statuesque size supports stout branches and plenty of acorns. Part shade to full sun.

#### White Pine Pinus strobus

Height of 50-70 feet, width of 20-40 feet. This bluish-green pine tree is a fast grower. Full sun to part shade.

#### Saucer Magnolia Magnolia x soulangeana

Height of 30 feet. The flowers appear in spring to early summer and are goblet- to cup- or saucer-shaped, up to ten inches wide.

#### Tina Crabapple Malus 'tina'

Height of 20-25 feet in the shape of a pyramid. This is a flowering tree which is in full bloom in the spring. The snow of winter accents fruit, branches and the tree shape.

#### Autumn Blaze Maple Acer rubrum

Height of 50-60 feet, width of 30-40 feet. This tree has summer color of a rich medium green with excellent scarlet, orange and red fall color.
