

Outdoor Pool Rules

- Parents or an adult guardian must accompany children ages 12 and under. An adult guardian must be within arm's reach for children 6 and under.
- Patrons who leave the facility MUST purchase another visit pass for re-entry.
- Admittance to the pool will be refused for: drunkenness, inability to care for self, open sores, contagious disease, diarrhea, head lice, respiratory infections, improper attire, and/or improper behavior
- Lifeguard instructions must be obeyed at all times.
- Children of diaper age or persons of all ages prone to incontinence are prohibited from entering the pool without a "waterproof swim diaper" or plastic pants with elastic legs and waistband. Child swim diapers are available for purchase at the Admissions Desk. Adults are required to change diapers in special areas provided in the bathhouse. Please do NOT change diapers on the pool deck or concession area.
- WALK—NO RUNNING!
- Diving is only allowed in specified areas (Liberty Pool only).
- No pushing, fighting, shoving, running, horseplay, public displays of affection, profanity or abusive language.
- No playing on handrails, ladders, stairs, ropes, and guard towers.
- NO smokeless tobacco, NO vapes, NO smoking, NO alcohol, NO drugs, NO glass containers, NO weapons, NO chewing gum, NO pets, and NO coolers.
- Appropriate swimwear must be worn at all times- no thongs, speedos, loose clothing, jean material, no street shoes in the pool.
- No electronic devices are allowed to be used in the bathhouses.
- Safe water toys are allowed in the facility (foam and floatable items). Toys deemed unsafe by management or being used in a manner which threatens the safety or enjoyment of patrons will be prohibited.
- No rafts or large inflatables; young child inflatables allowed with lifeguard approval.
- Lost or stolen articles are the responsibility of the owner. Lockers are available for patrons (bring own lock).
- No outside food, drinks, or coolers are allowed inside the pool facility.
- Animals are not allowed in the building or pool area, with the exception of guide dogs, which are allowed on the pool deck, but not in the water.
- No flips off the side of the pool.
- SPR staff reserves the right to check baggage if deemed appropriate.

SPR staff reserves the right to add additional rules that may be necessary for the safe operation of the facility.

Diving Boards

- No gainers, cut-a-ways, inwards or reverse dives allowed.
- All patrons using the diving board must be able to swim unassisted. Swimming test are available upon request. Patrons may be asked to take a swimming test before going off of the board.
- There is no recreational swimming in the diving area unless the diving boards are closed and the lifeguard on stand specifies that it is recreation swim time.
- No lifejackets or swim aides will be allowed when using the diving board or swimming in the dive well.
- No goggles, glasses, masks or fins will be allowed when using the diving board.
- Only one person is allowed on the diving board at a time.
- Only one bounce is allowed on the diving board.
- The previous diver must reach the pool ladder before the next diver can exit the diving board.
- Patrons must dive / jump straight off the end of the diving board.
- Divers are not allowed to sit, do handstands, cartwheels or any other unsafe dive on the diving board.
