HUBBARD PARK SPLASH PAD RULES

- Please use the splash pad at your own risk. The splash pad is an unsupervised facility.
- An adult must accompany children under 13 years of age. No child shall be left unattended at the splash pad.
- Proper attire must always be worn. Street shoes are prohibited on the splash pad. Sandals, water shoes, flip flops or appropriate deck wear is recommended for the splash pad.
- Swim diapers are required for all children under the age of 4 years old.
- All participants must conduct themselves in a courteous, safe, and family-oriented matter.
- Smoking is prohibited. Ord. No. 10099,
- No alcohol, glass, wheeled vehicles, stakeboards, or roller blades in the splash pad. Strollers, walkers, and wheelchairs are permitted.
- Climbing on splash pad features is stirctly prohibited.
- No running, horseplay, or profane language is permitted. Individuals engaging in unsafe or disruptive behavior will be asked to leave.
- No pets or animals are allowed in the splash pad area.
- No amplified music.
- No bathing, soap, detergent, or shampoo is allowed.
- Do not use splash pad if you feel ill, have open cuts, sores, lesions, infections, obvious communicatable diseases, or diarrhea.
- Be mindful of inclement weather. Splash pad must be vacated at the first sound of thunger or lighing.
- Splash pad may be closed any time due to weather, maintenance, or operational concerns.
- This splash pad used treated, recirculated water. DO NOT DRINK THE WATER.
