PRACTICES & GAMES

WHEN DO PRACTICES BEGIN?

Teams start practicing early/mid
April. Specific starting dates will
vary from team to team.

WHERE ARE PRACTICES HELD?

Practices will be held at various
fields throughout our parks.
Teams typically practice 2x a
week.

WHEN WILL I HEAR FROM MY COACH?

Coaches will start contacting
parents late March/early April,
following the Coaches Meeting
March 19th 6:00pm Convention
Hall.

WHAT WILL WE NEED?

Players must provide their own
glove. We also recommend
helmet, baseball pants, cup,
cleats (no metal).

Equipment (bats, balls, and
catcher's gear) will be provided.
Players receive a t-shirt and cap.

WHEN DO GAMES BEGIN?

Games begin early May and go
through mid/late June.

WHERE ARE GAMES HELD?

Games will primarily be held at
Centennial Park, Katy Park,
Vansell Field in Liberty Park , and
Housel Field depending on age
group.

Specific game times and number
of games during a season both
depend on the number of teams
in the league.

WHEN WILL I RECEIVE A GAME SCHEDULE?

Games schedules will be available
mid April. Parents can get
schedules from our website, or from
their coach.

TEAM SELECTION:

Teams will have 1 Head Coach and up to 2 Assistant Coaches. Coaches and their children will be assigned to the same team. All other children will be randomly assigned to a team in their respective league. Players are randomly selected in order to promote individual growth, create invaluable experiences, increase the competitive balance of games, and improve the overall quality of the Youth Baseball League.

ABOUT OUR PROGRAM:

- * This is a RECREATIONAL league; we stress teaching the basics & having fun.
- * Coaches in this league are volunteers. Usually they are parents just like yourself, and for some this is their first coaching experience.
- * Our preference is that you, the parents, are the coaches in this league. However, when we do not have enough parent volunteers for each team, we must ask individuals and community organizations outside the program for help.
- * If you would like your child to play at a highly competitive level, this type of league may not be the best fit for you. Our recommendation is to consider enrolling your child in one of the traveling teams in town. We say this only so that you find the appropriate league for your child and enjoy the experience.

COACHING: You don't have to be a baseball expert to be a good coach! This is a RECREATIONAL league - we're here to have fun!

To be a good coach, it is important to:

- Stress the importance of having FUN & good sportsmanship.
- Understand and follow the Rules & Regulations of our league.
- Know Baseball fundamentals or be willing to learn this information.
- Be reliable & responsible.

What to expect:

- A background check will be required in order to coach.
- A Coaches Meeting will be held Thursday, March 19 at 6:00 p.m. at Convention Hall.
- Practices will begin early/mid April.
- Games begin early May and last through mid/late June.
